

Les Harrison Volunteer of the Year Award

The Volunteer of the Year Award is based on the nominee's contributions to curling. The winner of the annual award will be recognized for their efforts during the current season and must be nominated/supported by a NBCA Affiliated Curling Centre.

Eligible volunteers include:

- Curler
- Coach
- Official
- Board member
- Committee member
- Ice maker
- Club member

Or anyone that has contributed in <u>any</u> of the following areas:

- Special event (i.e. championship hosted at the curling centre, anniversary celebrations);
- Building construction, renovations or upgrades (unpaid work);
- Program development for adults, juniors, youth or schools (elementary, secondary, collegiate, university);
- Specific fundraising campaign;
- Successful membership campaign;
- Successful volunteer recruitment;
- Paid staff where their contribution was above and beyond the job description they are responsible to carry out;
- Volunteers working on sanctioned national or international championships;
- NB curling volunteers at the zone, district, regional, provincial, national or international levels;
- Course conductors, instructors

Note: eligible nominations are not necessarily restricted to these areas. If your curling centre has a deserving and eligible volunteer who contributed in an area not listed here, please send it in. It will be considered equally.

The annual deadline for nominations is April 1.

A decision on the finalists and the winner will be formally announced at the NBCA Annual General Meeting in May.
