



Statement Regarding 2021 Seniors, Club and Mixed Championships

In these unprecedented times, Curling NB appreciates the full cooperation of all involved as we strive to act in the best interest of our athletes, coaches, umpires, club volunteers and our sport.

At this time, and after substantial consideration of the current state of the pandemic in the Province of New Brunswick, it is the decision of the Curling NB Return to Competitions Committee to postpone the 2021 NB Seniors, Club and Mixed Championships as follows:

- **2022 NB Mixed Championship:** This event is currently scheduled to be held March 18-21, 2021 in Grand Falls but is now scheduled for **April 8-11, 2021 at Capital Winter Club**. On-line registration will be available shortly with a registration deadline of March 18. The Canadian Mixed Championship is scheduled to take place November 7-13, 2021. (Please note that should restrictive conditions apply at the time of the April reschedule date, this event will be moved to the fall of 2021.)
- **2021 NB Seniors:** This event is currently scheduled to be held February 24-28 at Riverside Country Club. The revised dates and location are currently being negotiated and will be announced upon confirmation. That said, this event will be rescheduled for the fall of 2021. The Canadian Seniors Championships are scheduled to take place December 6-11, 2021.
- **2021 NB Curling Club Championships:** This event is currently scheduled to be held March 11-14, 2021 at Thistle St. Andrews. The revised dates are currently being negotiated and will be announced upon confirmation. That said, this event will be rescheduled for the fall of 2021. The Canadian Curling Club Championships are scheduled to take place November 28-December 4, 2021.
