This program funds projects that empower seniors in their communities and contribute to improving their health and well-being.

Eligible organizations can apply for up to \$25,000 for projects that are led by seniors and are volunteer based.

- Establishing new paths, trails and boardwalks through a conservation area; and
- Replacing an aging refrigeration system in an arena.
