

Curling NB is seeking candidates for four board positions at our upcoming annual meeting in May. Board members meet in person 3 to 4 times a year and another 3 to 4 times virtually (travel expenses are reimbursed). A high level look at the responsibilities is listed below.

Associate Vice-President

- Responsible for the promotion of curling throughout the province
- Chair special ad hoc or task force committees when requested
- Member of the Marketing and Sponsorship Committee
- Member of the Guidelines Committee
- Member of the Site Selection Committee
- Provincial Championship event liaison, when required
- Perform other such duties as delegated/requested by the President

NB Players Representative

- As a voting member, the NB Players' Rep will attend all meeting of the Curling NB Board of Directors (the Board).
- Bring matters of importance/concern received from registered Curling NB Competitive Athletes to the Board for discussion and consideration.
- Communicate regularly with members of the NB Players' Committee for the purpose of consultation on expressed matters of importance/concern. The NB Players' Committee should be in agreement on how such matters are presented to the Board.
- Ensure lines of communication are open and encouraged between registered Curling NB Competitive Athletes and the NB Players' Committee.

Northeast Zone Director

- Point of contact with the President of each curling centre within their zone to explain the functions of the Association and how we may be able to assist them throughout the year
- Communicate pertinent Board decisions to curling centres within the zone
- Be prepared to act as liaison to host committees of any Provincial Championships being hosted within the zone
- Attend all NBCA Board and General Meetings

Youth Development Director

- Hold a voting position on and attend all meetings of the Curling NB Board of Directors.
- Relay matters of concern received from youth player representatives to the Board of Directors.
- Coordinate and liaise with the Little Rocks Provincial, Canada Winter Games Provincial, Skills Development Program and Emerging Programs Coordinators.
- Provide a central point of contact and information sharing among Regional Liaisons.
- Act as Liaison to the Competitions Committee with respect to Junior Events leading to a
- National Championship.
- Represent Curling NB at Youth Events leading to a National Championship.
- Oversee the development and promotion of Provincial Youth Events which do not lead to a National
- Event.
- Promote the NB Youth Development Program throughout the Province of NB.
